

The Village of Argyle has received a grant to fund the rehabilitation of 16 single family, owner occupied homes in Argyle. The property must be for residential use only, and taxes must be current. Other criteria include annual income level shown on the individual's Federal Tax Return; adjustments can be made for discontinued income. Projects are prioritized: Priority A is structural repairs, Priority B is health, safety and energy efficiency related repairs, and Priority C is appearance related repairs. The grant will not cover portable items (rugs, appliances), outside buildings, driveways, fences, etc.

Applications and further information are available at the Argyle town office. Information will be kept confidential and the final selection for grant award will be chosen by Marvin and Company.
